Dear Parents

The Youth Section has continued to build on the success of previous seasons such that the long-term future of the club is sound. There is a genuine opportunity for all youngsters to progress through all youth levels and on into the senior football. The club has three full-size pitches, a three-quarter size pitch, a 3G all-weather training pitch and a mini-soccer area that ensures the Wendron club remains a force in the future. Minimum age for entry of new members will be six years old by the 1st September 2014 as no insurance is available country wide for younger players. To ensure adequate supervision and control it is essential that boys/girls attend only the age group session allocated to their date of birth.

NB: Parents/guardians are responsible for their boys/girls delivery to and from the training area. It is suggested that boys/girls should bring a change of clothing and a towel. Parents are also requested to check beforehand to see if training is going to take place should inclement weather arise. Managers/Trainers must not be left in the position of sole responsibility for children when others have gone home, especially if we are to comply with Child Protection Regulations.

PLEASE NOTE:- IT IS AN F.A. RULING THAT ALL PLAYERS MUST WEAR SHIN PADS AT ALL MATCHES AND TRAINING SESSIONS, BEFORE THEY ARE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE.

ADMINISTRATION/PARENT SUPPORT

The Wendron Club is now one of the largest youth set-ups in Cornwall and is consequently a major organisational challenge. There is an urgent need for parents to support the club or assist in fundraising activities. Volunteers are required to assist with coaching, control, refreshments, shirt washing, match referees and particularly transport when away matches are arranged. Any parent willing to manage a team is requested to contact the Chairman.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

Unfortunately due to rising costs we have had to increase our annual membership fee is **£60.00**, with the first additional family member costing £30.00 and any subsequent family members being free. The Annual membership includes Parent Social Membership of £5.00. If parents would like to spread the payments of the coming months before the September deadline then please do so. If any parent is having difficulty please talk to their manager in confidence and the club will try to accommodate payments spread over the start of the season. For those on benefit (i.e. Job Seekers Allowance or Income Support) the payment can be made in instalments - please contact the Chairman in confidence. Payment will only be accepted if accompanied by the attached form and must be passed to your Age Group Membership Secretary/Manager.

Please note that due to a change in the club's insurance requirements, all players will be required to have signed on and paid their club membership fees by Monday 2nd September 2013. Any players who have not paid by this date will not be permitted to play for the club in any league or cup competitions.

PLAYER'S FINES

Please note that any players that receive fines from the League arising from dissent to match officials or violent conduct, will be liable for the payment of those fines. Fines received for other offences will be paid for by the club.

DISCOUNT ON SPORTS EQUIPMENT

INSURANCE

Though the club takes out insurance cover for all members for capital benefits (permanent damage), some parents might wish to take out private insurance for any alternative cover that they require. The managers and coaches take all reasonable care with the children in their charge but do not wish to be liable in the event of an accident. It will therefore be necessary for you to sign a disclaimer before your son/daughter can participate in weekly sessions. All managers/coaches will have attended, or will attend an FA child protection course.

HELP THE MANAGER (COACHES / TRAINERS / LINESMEN / REFEREES)

If we are to be successful at all age groups parents must become involved in running teams. At present the club requires managers to organise friendlies for the younger age groups. Please volunteer if you can assist in any way. Please notify non-availability for matches and cut telephone costs by contacting the manager in good time, especially when the weather is bad. Parents should advise when they can assist with transport and also ensure that those participating in matches pay the **match fee** of £2. This is an essential source of income to the operating costs of the team

CHILD PROTECTION

FA RESPECT CAMPAIGN

Please note that it is a requirement of the Kernow League that all Clubs adhere to the FA's Respect campaign for the forthcoming season. This will mean that all spectators at matches will have to remain behind a line/barrier that is at least 1m from the touchline on one side of the pitch only, with coaches/managers on the opposite side. No spectators are to stand at the end of the pitch. The campaign is aimed at removing abuse of players and match officials from the game and the pressurisation of players by coaches/managers and parents. Please help us to maintain the Club's reputation by recognising and applauding good play and sportsmanship regardless of whether it comes from the home or away side.
