



## YOUNG PLAYERS FA RESPECT CODE OF CONDUCT

It is important everyone behaves themselves when playing football. As a player, you have a big part to play. That's why The FA is asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

### WHEN PLAYING FOOTBALL I WILL:

- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team.
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, dive, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee.
- Be gracious in victory and defeat – I will shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game.
- Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me.
- No use foul or abusive language at any time when representing Ringwood Town FC.
- Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team and not one individual player.
- Talk to someone I trust or the Club Welfare Officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my Club.

I understand that if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, Cornwall FA or the FA:

### I MAY:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the Club Committee
- Be deselected or substituted
- Not be invited to training
- Be required to leave the Club

### IN ADDITION:

- My Club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct.
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.

## SPECTATORS FA RESPECT CODE OF CONDUCT

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

This club is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed by everyone in a safe and positive environment. Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times

I WILL:

- Remain outside the field of play and behind the Designated Spectator Area (where provided).
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Always respect the match officials' decisions.
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- Remember that children play for FUN.
- Let the coaches do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition and match officials.
- Never criticise a player for making a mistake - mistakes are part of learning.
- Report any concerns I have to the team manager, club welfare officer or the chairman of the club.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken:

I MAY BE:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a Club or league official.
- Required to meet with the Club, league or County FA Welfare Officer.
- Required to meet with the Club Committee.
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course.
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the Club.
- Requested by the Club not to attend future games.
- Suspended or have my Club membership removed.
- Required to leave the Club along with any dependents.

IN ADDITION:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on you.
